




















































## Health Research – Horizon Europe (2021-27)

#### Health cluster: 6 "destinations":

- 1. Staying healthy in a rapidly changing society
- 2. Living and working in a health-promoting environment
- 3. Tackling diseases and reducing disease burden
- 4. Ensuring access to innovative, sustainable and high-quality health care
- 5. Unlocking the full potential of new tools, technologies and digital solutions for a healthy society
- 6. Maintaining an innovative, sustainable and globally competitive health industry

## Health Research – Horizon Europe (2021-27)

- Cancer Mission objectives:
  - > to understand cancer, its risk factors and impact;
  - > to **prevent** what is preventable;
  - > to optimise diagnostics and treatment;
  - and to support the quality of life of people living with and after cancer, while ensuring equitable access for all.

## Calls for proposals 2023-2024

#### **2023** Cluster 1 calls for proposals

 Single-stage calls, 29 topics indicative EU budget: €847 million Deadline: 13 April 2023

#### **2024** Cluster 1 calls for proposals

Two-stage calls, 9 topics\*
 EU indicative budget: €320 million

Deadline: 19 Sept. 2023 & 11 April 2024
 Single-stage call, 6 topics
 indicative EU budget: €189 million
 Deadline: 11 April 2024

#### **2023** Cancer Mission call for proposals:

Single-stage call, 4 topics
 Indicative EU budget: €110.7m
 Deadline: 12 April 2023,

#### **2024** Cancer Mission call for proposals:

Work programme to be published end-2023.

- HORIZON-HLTH-2023-DISEASE-03-04: Pandemic preparedness and response: Broad spectrum anti-viral therapeutics for infectious diseases with epidemic potential Opening: 12 Jan 2023 | Deadline: 13 Apr 2023
- HORIZON-HLTH-2024-DISEASE-03-13-two-stage: Validation of fluid-derived biomarkers for the prediction and prevention of brain disorders
   Opening: 30 Mar 2023 | Deadline(s): 19 Sep 2023 (First Stage), 11 Apr 2024 (Second Stage)
- HORIZON-HLTH-2024-DISEASE-08-20: Pandemic preparedness and response: Host-pathogen interactions of infectious diseases with epidemic potential
  Opening: 26 Oct 2023 | Deadline: 11 Apr 2024

Indian government – Department of Biotechnology (DBT) – will fund Indian partners.

## Funding collaborative research – basic principles

- Annual work programmes published or updated each year
- Funding rate: up to 100% of eligible costs for most topics + 25% for indirect costs
- Collaborative research projects: min. 3 independent legal entities from 3 different EU
  Member States (min 1) or associated countries
- Partners from 3<sup>rd</sup> countries can be included, without funding for industrialised countries
- Single-stage OR two-stage application process
- Peer review by panels of independent experts;
  3 evaluation criteria (Excellence, Impact, Implementation)
- Ethics screening
- Grant Agreement Preparation: max. 8 months from submission to signing grant agreement
- Reporting on scientific progress and on financial aspects (every 12 or 18 months)
